

## Beaded Wire Heart

### Materials

Wire heart frame  
2 x 1.5m 26g wire  
Hessian string  
wire cutters  
needle nosed pliers  
scissors

### Beads


hearts x 9  
tiny seed size 11 x 18  
small seed size 10 x 40  
med round size 6 x 10  
large round size 4 x 10  
bugle x 10

### Dangler


heart bead  
tiny silver beads x 2  
silver spacer beads x 2  
headpin x 35mm  
jump ring



**You will need 38 x 4 “sets” of beads plus 1 x 3 “set” of beads**

Wrap one end of the wire around the base of the hook on the frame.

Wrap wire around frame 5 times.

Thread on the first bead set.

Twist the wires below the bead.

Wrap the wire 5 times around the frame.

Add the next bead set.

Continue till you reach the point of the heart frame.

Spread the wire out so the bead sets fill the first side of the heart.

Secure end of the wire by wrapping around the point of the frame .

Add new length of wire by wrapping 5 loops onto frame.

Continue adding beads to the second side of the frame.

On reaching the top, spread the wire out so the bead sets fill the second half of the frame.

Wrap the wire around the hook to secure it.

Make the central dangler.


Onto a head pin: Thread tiny silver bead, silver spacer, heart bead, silver spacer, tiny silver bead.

Make a loop in the top of the head pin.

Loop through a jump ring.

Attach the dangler to the wire frame using the jump ring.

# Beaded Wire Heart



Wrap wire around hook to secure



Wind on 5x. Add 1st set of beads.



Twist wire below bead.



Wind on 5x.



Add 2nd set of beads.



Wind on 5x.



Continue adding sets of beads. Spread wire out to fill frame.



At heart point add 2nd piece of wire by winding on 5x.



Finish with 5 loops at hook.



Secure by winding around hook.



Make the central dangle



Add the central dangle & hang up
